Your request for construction water use, for the above referenced hydrant number, is approved subject to the following conditions:

1) The Applicant agrees:

- a) To provide a \$1000.00 damage deposit at time of issuance.
- b) To pay a meter and hydrant wrench rental fee of \$10.00 per day (non pro-rated, non refundable).
- c) To assume full responsibility for any repairs to damaged Village property.
Any damages must be reported immediately to the Superintendent of Public Works and repairs will be made at the Village's discretion
- e) To log the weekly use of water used for Public Works to record.
- d) To allow Village employees to inspect water use and connections.

Statements will be billed reflecting the readings of the meter and will be subject to Village Municipal Code Section 6-5-4-24 & 6-5-4-25 regarding charges and late delinquent charges.

If the Applicant fails to log meter readings, the Applicant will automatically be billed a Standard Load Count of 50,000 gallons with all other fees incurred over the time of issuance or last billing, with no further credit issued when actual reading is obtained.

- 2) The Applicant agrees to use the meter at all times when obtaining water to ensure all water that is used is metered and paid for or face penalties up to \$500.00 under Village Code 6-5-8-2.
- 3) Water may only be drawn from the assigned fire hydrant.
- 4) The Applicant must comply with all applicable Village of Thornton and IEPA Water Specifications, including back flow prevention and cross connection standards.
- 5) Fire Department Requirements include:
 - a) Hydrant permitted for use shall remain accessible for Fire Department use at all times. A minimum of a three foot clearance shall be maintained.
 - b) Water meter is to be removed when not in immediate use (i.e. daily) and hydrant appropriately drained after each use.
